
The Problem

From April 2009 to June 2010, American Police Departments spent approximately \$350 million in settlements and judgments related to misconduct allegations. During this time, nearly 6000 police misconduct charges were filed. The largest category of these cases was Excessive Use of Force. Even though most cases were related to a single or small group of officers, most resulted in lawsuits against entire departments and/or municipalities.**

The Solution

Integrated Status Tracking

Statuses represent how much time is available before a person becomes delinquent with meeting a training or refresher requirement. Individual and team statuses are automatically saved in a database, and officers' statuses are immediately updated to reflect training sessions. Users with supervisory roles have the ability to view their subordinates' training status in both summary and detailed modes. They can 'drill-down' from rolled-up scores all the way to viewing the entire course history for any individual officer and any individual course.



Dynamic Resistance & Response Model

Developed by Chuck Joyner, the DRM enables officers to quickly assess situations and select the proper tools and techniques to bring suspects into compliance with maximum safety for all parties.


Course Creation
